
SUNDAY, APRIL 8, 11:30AM MEETS IN CHAPEL

2017 CHARITABLE GIVING TAX CUTS

Did you know? You can still donate to an Arizona charity (including many Saint Barnabas mission partners) and reduce your 2017 Arizona tax bill. Taxpayers have until April 17, 2018, to take advantage of the state's Charitable Tax Credit, applying it to their 2017 state tax bill. The credit can cut your final tax bill by \$1 for each \$1 donated, up to \$400 for individuals and \$800 for couples. Qualifying partners include Bridging AZ Furniture Bank, the Challenge Foundation, Family Promise and Habitat for Humanity.
