

EASTER AT SAINT BARNABAS

This joyous season starts with Easter Day as we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Easter season then continues for 50 days. Throughout this time, we hear the stories of how Jesus appeared to his followers in many ways after his resurrection; we hear what he taught them about how to live, and how to carry on the mission to make disciples. During this time, we also celebrate his Ascension into heaven (which Saint Barnabas also likes to move to a Sunday so we don't miss the celebration!). This is followed by the arrival of the Holy Spirit, which we celebrate on Pentecost.

The purpose of this retreat facilitated by **Liza Bell** is to assist the participants in exploring and developing a greater understanding of the benefits and nuances of the practice of centering prayer. The first day offers an in-depth look at the practice itself, utilizing the Quiet Day teachings of Rev. Jim Clark. The remaining days involve the experiential nature of group silence, which facilitates a gentle interior silence, opening our hearts to God's divine therapy.

As Fr. Thomas Keating so eloquently states...

"Interior silence is one of the most strengthening and affirming of human experiences. There is nothing more affirming, in fact, than the experience of God's presence. That revelation says as nothing else can, "You are a good person. I created you and I love you." Divine love brings us into being in the fullest sense of the word. It heals the negative feelings we have about ourselves."

Join us! Prepare to be 'loved on' by the beauty of it all. Please note: This retreat also welcomes those who have had a practice of silence, but feel the need for a 'refresher'.
