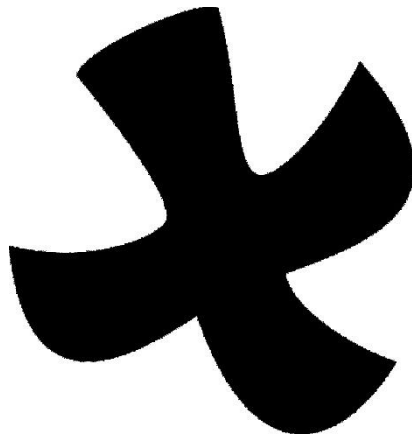

may our hearts sing your praises forever.

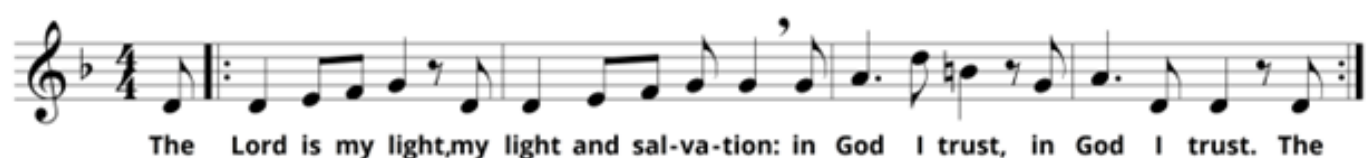
