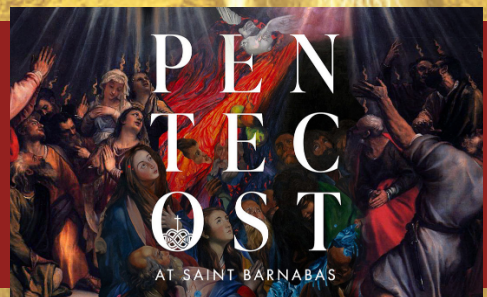
► **YOUR LEGACY IS EVERY LIFE YOU TOUCHED.**
